Local 4400 Member Scholarship

Eight (8) scholarships of \$1,000.00 will be awarded in June 2012 to Members of CUPE Local 4400. These scholarships will be awarded to a member who is enrolled in post secondary education, including, but not limited to, university, college, technical institute, teacher's college, nursing school, etc. Should the full-time scholarships not all be awarded, the funds will be used for part-time scholarships.

Applicants are to prepare a commentary on the following topic:

The provinces and the cities are crying “broke” even as wealth accumulates at the top in record amounts. The facts are that 1% of Canada’s population owns 99% of the wealth.

How and why did this happen?

In your essay, examine ways that the wealth can be more fairly re-distributed: i.e. fair taxation, free university tuition, etc.

Parameters of Commentary: provide any type of commentary you want – i.e. essay, photo display, Power Point presentation, poem, artwork (of manageable size) to illustrate your point concerning the above topic.

This award is being given by Local 4400 for the purpose of supporting further education for members.

An individual is entitled to receive only one full-time Local 4400 scholarship.

To apply for the Scholarship, please complete the attached Application Form and return, together with your Commentary and required documentation, to the Local 4400 Scholarship Committee (see submission details on Form). The deadline is February 17, 2012 and the scholarships will be awarded in June 2012.
